ONLINE TRAINING IS CHANGING

complyND is the University's new digital solution that allows the assignment and tracking of all required safety training. Starting November 16, 2015, all laboratory personnel who are required to take laboratory safety training must do so within complyND. The VIVID online training system is being phased out.

- Complete any outstanding training in Vivid by 12/1/15. Personnel, who have been assigned training through Vivid, must complete this training by December 1, 2015. Course assignments not completed or partially completed in VIVID will not be migrated to *complyND*. If the course is not completed by 12/1/15 in Vivid then the training must be re-assigned and taken in its entirety in *complyND*.
- **Print all completed course certificates.** Although records will be maintained, it is recommended that you print all Vivid course certificates of completion or save them to a local device for later retrieval.

Future course assignments:

- Risk Management and Safety (RMS) will be assigning refresher training through complyND approximately 1 year after course completion
- complyND requires Notre Dame NetID; therefore, non-Notre Dame personnel (high schoolers, volunteers, visiting researchers, etc.) will not be transferred from Vivid to complyND. These individuals must obtain an ND NetID, click here for instructions, and get assigned by their ND supervisor/PI or complyND Department Contact (click here for the list).

Starting November 9, 2015, complyND will have the following laboratory safety training courses available for use:

Each department has identified an individual to serve as the *complyND* Department Contact. This person is capable of establishing a supervisor relationship in ComplyND for students, post-docs, visiting faculty and researchers or others who are not Notre Dame personnel. The supervisor or PI/ designee can then assign the required training.
