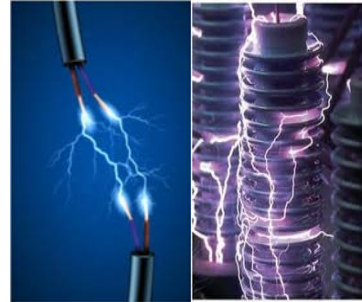

OSHA Compliance

RMS is considering hosting an electrical safety training course. This is for personnel who perform work on live electrical systems, such as testing and troubleshooting, laboratory electrical experiments, or other tasks where exposure to energized parts is a possibility.

This training addresses electrical safety-related work practices that are necessary for safeguarding employees from hazards when exposed to live electrical energy and assists in complying with OSHA 1910 Subpart S.

Attendees will be provided handouts to assist in electrical safety. Upon completion, each student will receive a Certificate of Completion.



RMS is planning on hosting this 3-4 hour course this February 2018 if there is sufficient interest.

The training is designed for personnel who work with energized live electrical systems greater than 50 volts (including testing, troubleshooting and voltage measuring), who supervise personnel working on these systems, and any safety committee members in departments where these types of activities take place.

RMS will cover all associated expenses for the course.
