New Hazardous Materials Shipping Service 24/7 Emergency Contact and Response

There are many regulatory requirements for shipping hazardous materials (HazMat) from campus to other locations. To ensure compliance with the following requirement, the University has signed a contract with InfoTrac. They will provide both domestic and international emergency contact numbers which are monitored 24 /7.

Requirement:

"An emergency contact number must be provided on the shipping papers and monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The emergency contact number must also connect to a person who has immediate access to comprehensive information about the shipped hazardous material."
