

Safety Data Sheets & MSDS Online Tool

The University of Notre Dame is moving towards using a tool called MSDSOnline for storing and managing Safety Data Sheets.

What are Safety Data Sheets?

A Safety Data Sheet, or SDS, is a standard document that communicates safety and health data on research or industrial chemicals. The International Hazard Communication Standard mandates that employers must communicate a chemical's hazard information by providing a SDS to all personnel who may use, or be within the vicinity of these chemicals. SDSs are also a critical tool used by emergency responders and Notre Dame personnel in the event of an exposure or accidental release.



What is MSDSOnline?

MSDSOnline is a single platform where SDSs can be uploaded, viewed, and accessed by anyone who has a University NetID and password. The link to MSDSOnline is available through the quick links portion of the RMS home page, as well as the RMS <u>Hazard Communication Page</u>.

The goal is to move the University to use this online system by the summer of 2020.
