IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING CHANGES IN MEDICAL TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR WORK RELATED INJURIES

Medical treatment for injuries incurred at work will continue to be administered on campus by the University's Wellness Center during their normal hours of operation (click here).

Effective **Sunday**, **October 27**, **2019**, Medpoint24 will no longer treat patients 24 hours a day. Due to this change, supervisors and managers should use the following options for after hours medical care for injured employees:

<u>For Minor Injuries</u> — Use the on call feature provided by the Wellness Center by calling 574-634-9355 and selecting the on-call provider option. This option can provide guidance on treatment for the injured employee.

For Injuries Requiring Immediate/Emergency Care — St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center (SJRMC), continues to be our emergency medical treatment facility. SJRMC is located at 5215 Holy Cross Parkway in Mishawaka off Douglas Rd.
